The Department has heard from unofficial sources of massacres of Greeks and Armenians stated to have been perpetrated last summer at Marsovan. It is also stated that some American Relief workers were there at the time, and that a fire destroyed a considerable part of the city.

I will feel much obliged if you will be so kind as to send me, for the files of the Department, any information which you may have on the subject.
